**AGREEMENT TO SERVE**

Whereas, central water and sewer service is currently available, or will be available in the near future, to Customer's property as a result of the installation of facilities in Walton County, Florida, and WHEREAS, Customer desires that the Regional Utilities System of Walton County Service Co. is willing to provide such service in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein: WHEREAS, statements are mailed on or near the last date of the month and are due by the delinquent date shown on each statement, generally within 20 days of the billing date shown on each statement. Failure to pay by the delinquent date will result in a 10% service charge applied to the unpaid balance on the statement. Bills not paid within 45 days will result in a discontinuance of service and a reconnection fee charge. An amount two times the initial deposit may be required. Now, THEREFORE, in consideration of the agreement contained herein (including the utility service conditions). Customer and Service Company agree and cause the Agreement to be executed. Customer agrees that the fire suppression system will only be used in the event of a fire or for equipment testing purposes. Should it be determined that the Customer utilizes, Customer, his successors or assigns, shall be liable to Service Company for such an additional capacity at the charge in existence at the time of such determination. All charges are subject to the approval of the government body, or agency, or subdivision, of government, having authority over this agreement, and such charges shall change in accordance with order or appropriate directive of such authority. The charge for General Service shall at no time be less than the minimum charge of Fire Suppression. Water usage by this service for any purpose other than fire suppression is prohibited. If used for any other purpose, the water will be charged at a penalized rate and the service will be disconnected. Customer agrees that damages to meters by the property owner's or property owner's contractors, will be the responsibility of the owner and that replacement costs or service costs associated with relocating or replacing the meter, will be paid by the owner. Disconnection may result from unpaid meter damages. Company's responsibility ends at the meter. Any calls for service determined not to be the Company's responsibility will incur the service charge imposed.

Regional Utilities Standard Specifications and Details shall apply to the service being applied for in addition to the following:

- All fire suppression systems and connections shall be designed and approved by a licensed Professional Engineer and/or licensed Fire Suppression System Design Contractor.
- Regional Utilities is not responsible for reviewing the design of the fire suppression system.
- All fire line connections shall be in compliance with NFPA 13 and NFPA 24.
- The fire line may tap off of an existing or newly installed potable water service line so long as the line is capable of sustaining pressure requirements for both the potable and fire lines.
- All fire line connections will require a Reduced Pressure Zone.

Backflow prevention requirements are noted in AWWA's Manual M14, "Recommended Practice for Backflow Prevention and Cross-Connection Control." This manual is incorporated as a reference by FDEP Rule 62-555.330(6), Florida Administrative Code.

- All Rpz's require inspection and testing by a TREEO or FWPCOA certified tester at the time water service becomes available and annually thereafter.
- All fire line connections shall require a meter. Meters will be purchased and installed by Regional Utilities (deposit required).
- All taps greater than 2.0" in diameter shall be performed by Regional Utilities.
- Hot tap fees are based on tap size and cost \$100.00 per inch.
- REGIONAL UTILITIES MUST BE ONSITE PRIOR TO PERFORMING THE TAP.

I have read this document in-full and agree to install the proposed utilities in accordance with the conditions detailed above in addition to all applicable Federal, State and Local standards including, but not limited to, those specified by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Regional Utilities, Walton Co. Building Department, and South Walton Fire District.

Failure to complete application in full could result in a delay of service.
