Grayton Beach Potable Water Upgrade

You may have noticed Regional Utilities workers in Grayton Beach over the last month or so. We have been in the midst of our Grayton Beach Potable Water Upgrade Project that consists of replacing and upgrading approximately 1,500 feet of potable water line, along with relocating services and meters to more efficiently serve the neighborhood. The majority of the water lines replaced were nearing or had reached the end of their service life. This project will provide better looping of the system which will provide more consistent pressures and flow capabilities.

Water Metering Equipment Change Out Project Update

The Water Metering Equipment Change Out Project first began on April 9, 2018, in an effort to change out meters in our service area. These periodic change outs are essential when it comes to staying up to date with the latest capabilities the meter reading industry has to offer while also expediting the meter reading process. To date our team has completed 10,000 of the approximately 17,000 change outs needed to complete the project. Currently, our team is working in the Seagrove area and will continue on throughout the entire service area until the project's completion.
