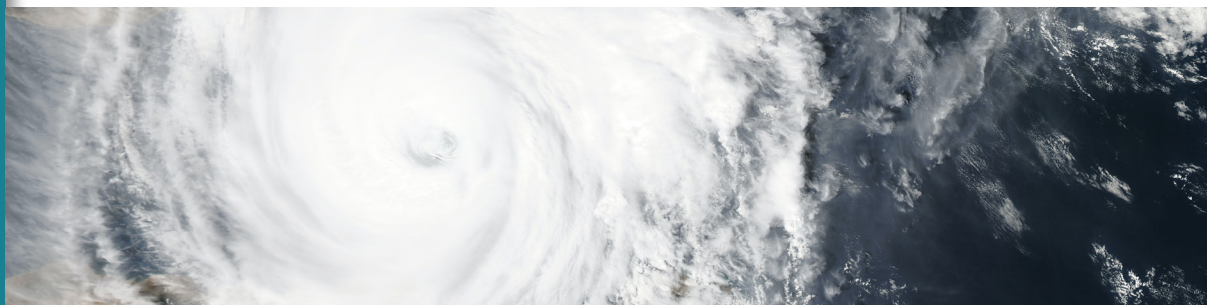

Preparing for Hurricane Season

It's essential that everyone living near the Gulf Coast prepare for the possibility of a hurricane. While there are many ways to protect your home and yourself, you can also protect your water supply and property from damage by following these guidelines.

- If you evacuate, turn off the water to your house at your own cutoff valve. Having your own cutoff valve will be easier to operate than the meter shut off valve. This will help minimize damage to your home's interior if a pipe burst inside your home.
- If you evacuate and turn your water off, make sure to turn off the hot water heater.
- Sign up for Waterscope, our newest customer support option that provides water customers information such as meter readings and the ability to sign up for daily alerts.
- Piles of tree limbs and other debris should be kept away from hydrants, water meters, manhole covers and other exposed utility lines because they can damage plumbing pipes to your house.
- Turn off any pool pumps, remove the hoses and protect them.
